








## **Self Teaching Materials**



#### **Progression**

Your eTwinning progression is determined by two factors: your participation in eTwinning and the usage of Self Teaching Materials. They both in cate of how far you are in your eTwinning Journey.

The Progression assess on your participation in eTwinning is divided into five areas; Basics, Communication, Collaboration, Networking and Professional Development and Quality. Examples of actions which will make you progression increase are:

- > Basics: login, write project idea, add a profile picture, write posts in your profile.
- > Communication: contacts, follow people, write internal message.
- Collaboration: project membership, using the TwinSpace.
- > Professional Development and networking: Groups' membership, participation in events and other PD activities.
- > Quality: organising events, moderating Groups, Quality Labels.

Bear in mind that there is always a limit to how many things of the same category you can do to increase your progression bar: after writing a number of messages or posts your progression will not change!

The progression can also be based on the **Self Teaching Materials** which you can take to improve your eTwinning experience. You can find such materials on the platform.

**Remember:** your progression is visible to everyone within eTwinning and can act as a guide as to your eTwinning experience and active participation.
